





#### A specific case: Revised marketing standards

Revision of 2 Regulations will start to apply from 1.1.2025:

- Delegated Regulation 2023/2429 for marketing standards;
- Implementing Regulation 2023/2430 for the control of the compliance with the marketing standards.

The main element relevant to hazelnuts is the compulsory indication of the origin.



### AGRINFO – information on agri-food policy changes

- An online information service on evolving EU policies, regulations and standards with potential impacts on agri-food value chains.
- Clear summaries for trade partners about the "what, why, and when" of recent and upcoming changes, and actions needed to adjust to new rules.

  - potential impacts of changes for AGRINFO partners and the actions they need to take.
